

Subject: Goodyear Tires - 1967 Model GT 350 and 500


The purpose of this memo is to eliminate the apparent confusion on tires for the 1967 model build.

The following decisions have been reached on the tire problem:

1. The present tire will be installed on the GT 350 and 500 cars through the September and October build (approximately 230 vehicles). The present tire displays "Goodyear" in 1 3/4 inch letters. Further the tire will have "350" opposite the "Goodyear".
2. Changes in the mold have been requested by Shelby American personnel as follows:
 - . Reduce size of "Goodyear" to 3/4 inch
3. After the molds have been changed to 3/4 inch Goodyear, the present tire will be discontinued.
4. Cost of changing, modifying or replacing molds will be negotiated by Ron Cramin.
5. All further contracts with Goodyear on tires will be made by or through Ron Cramin.
