Subject: Special Build of 250 Mustang Hardtops for Trans-American Sedan Races

An important part of Ford Division's 1967 racing program will be the Trans-American Sedan Series. We have only recently learned that all major U. S. manufacturers will directly or indirectly enter compact sedans in the Trans-American program, beginning with the first race in Daytona Beach, Florida, on February 3, 1967. Accordingly, it has become necessary to expedite our Mustang sedan race car build and development program in order to make vehicles available in time for the Daytona race.

In view of the immediacy of this program, we request that ten special Mustang hardtops as per the attached specifications be built and delivered to Shelby-American by the San Jose Assembly Plant on an expedited basis. Three of these cars should be delivered before January 1, 1967.
